FUND RAISING ACTIVITIES

At the present time the Post has only one Fund Raising Activity and that is the BINGO GAME THAT IS CONDUCTED FRIDAY EVENINGS AT THE RETIRED ENLISTED ASSOCIATION at 834 EMORY CIRCLE.

It takes 13 to fourteen people to effectively run the game of Bingo and the Pull tabs operations. The positions are described below.

annotat that number on the

We have two front clerks that take care of selling the packets for the bingo game and also selling the bingo daubers, and the collection of the money from the players.

The pulltab games consist of the \$.25 games (called sml jars) and the \$1.00 games (called lrg jars) this consists of a total of 4-6 workers in order to give the workers a rest and also to act as payout clerk for the winners.

As the game of bingo improves and players increase we need two workers on the floor to call back the bingo to the caller. This position a worker could sit down between bingos if they desired.

We need to have two callers for the evening. One to call the first half and one

to call the second half. The only workers that need to be present by six o'clock at night are the pulltabs sellers and the front clerks.

Everyone else could come in by seven o'clock. The first half begins at 7:00 p.m. with the first bingo number being called and the half ends by 8:00 p.m. We take a ten to fifteen minute breaks and start the second half. The second half is usually completed by 9:30 pm at the latest.

The only ones that need to stay after that again is the pulltabs sellers and the bingo chairman and lately we have been getting done no later than 11 o'clock but again with the increase of the Bingo and players this could be later.

I am enclosing a schedule of personnel who have volunteered their time for the month of November. You will see that there are some spaces open and we need your help. am requesting you please do some soul-searching and see if you can't givethe Poste a couple of hours at least ONCE A MONTH as that would help greatly. 




