A.M. to 9:00 P.M., Eastern time daily. House Veterans Affairs Panel voted to extend the VA's obligation to provide hospital care and medical service to Gulf War veterans with possible ailments resulting from service in the Gulf War.

The Fort Carson Pharmacy out-patient service is available from 0900 hours to 1700 hours daily, Monday through Friday. You may phone 10 days ahead for fast service.

Many veterans have not received disability benefits due to not understanding the rules. Any condition which was caused or aggravated while you were on active duty is considered to be service-connected, and a claim can be filed for benefits.

Social Security questions and request for service can be secured by calling 1-800-772-1213 daily. Also if you are on the internet on your computer, you can contact them at Attp://www.ssa.gov. 24 hours a day, 365 days per year.


Please do your service officer a special favor and remember in your prayers the Miller family, Matthew who does not know when he will be able to come home, his wife Tammy and four children.

Happy New Year!


