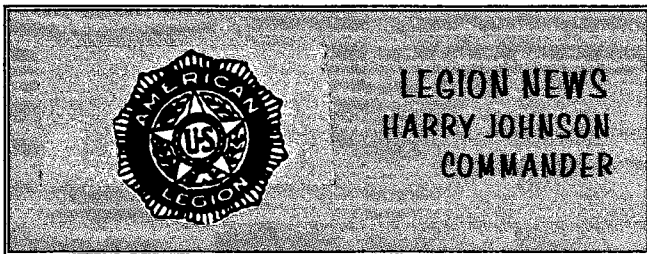

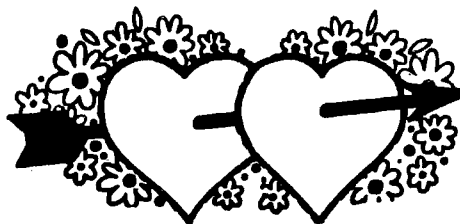
## AUXILIARY MEMBERSHIP

Auxiliary membership stands at 62%. Come on you laggards...get your membership into the office. Last year we ended up over 100% and we surely don't want to be under that this year.

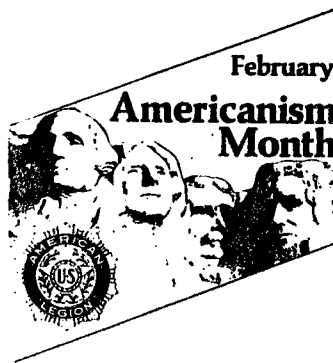

We now have 286 members. That puts us at better than 55%. If we can get 14 more, we will have 60%. As has been previously stated by the Commander and the Finance Officer, we need members to have a better voice for all veterans. But, even if you are not concerned about your fellow veterans, you should be concerned about yourself!

Last Thursday evening, 23 Jan 97, I attended a TRICARE briefing at the Air Force Academy. It is painfully obvious that we have some serious choices to make, if we are in the CHAMPUS category. Those 65 and older need to be enrolled in Medicare Part B. If you did not attend the briefing I did, then you need to go to the one that will be at McMahon Theater at Fort Carson on 1 Feb 97 starting at 8:00 am, or you need to call the Peterson AFB Clinic for their schedule. There are advantages and disadvantages to each of the TRICARE plans. You will have to make up your own mind about what you want to do, because each person and/or family's situation is unique to them. However, you need to get the brochure and get yourself set up to receive the forms now. Enrollment will be on a first come, first serve basis. If you prefer to be treated at the military treatment facility and you want to express that, you will be in competition with all of the rest of us

for the less than half slots that will be available to the total retiree eligible population in our area. The forms will be available 20 Feb 97 and retiree processing will start 3 Mar 97. If you wait until then, you will be looking at mostly all civilian providers and care, except where you can get medications, lab tests, etc. done at the military facility. Thus, the hour has come and now is the time to act!

I attended the Mid-Year Conference at Fort Collins and it was excellent. We received many reports from within and without The American Legion. I will try to cover the important highlights.

Boy's State will be at the University of Southern Colorado, Pueblo, 8 - 14 Jun 97 and the cost will be \$150.00 per boy. Counselors are needed and the men do not have to belong to The Legion, so if you know of anyone who could do this, please contact John McCartney by calling 1-800-477-1655 and asking to be connected to him.

We had excellent reports from various VA representatives in our area and we can be thankful that they are able to do a good job with the resources they have at this time. However, they could do more, if we can convince Congress to vote for the GI Bill of Health.

The 1998 Mid-Year Conference and Department Convention will be at the Holiday Inn in Estes Park in order to get the best possible rates.

There will be a State Veterans Nursing Home and Domiciliary at the Fitzsimons campus in the future. VA plans an outpatient clinic for sometime this year. Many other users will be health care related. The Mayor of Aurora, Paul Tauer, received an award Saturday night at the banquet for his many efforts to insure the military was not forgotten in the plans for the Fitzsimons campus.

The Americanism chair, B. J. Runchel, reported that less than 49% of the nation's voters went to the polls the last election. Clinton was elected by less than 25%. Colorado voters did much better as they had 62% voting. He also stated the proponents of Amendment 11 are already at work to try something else in this area. We need to watch this and defeat it again.

More volunteers are needed by VA, both at the Hospital and at the Regional Office due to the many cutbacks they have had to implement.

There will be a Rededication of Post 2 in Pueblo on 16 Feb 97 at 2:00 pm. At this time the Post will be given the name, Ovie Vernon Post 2, in honor of our Past Department Commander, Alternate National Executive Committeeman, and National Executive Committeeman. Ovie was very active at levels of The American Legion and this is a wonderful to honor his service.
