
# CENTENNIAL POST 209 THE AMERICAN LEGION

# FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES LARRY JOHNSON, CHAIRMAN


Our one major fundraising activity is the game of Bingo, conducted every Friday evening (provided we have enough volunteers) at 7:00 P.M.

February 4 Board of Trustees Meeting; Executive Committee Mtg February 19 - General Meeting PROOF OF SERVICE PROJECT REPORT: Many thanks to those listed below who now have their proof of service on file with us. Last month we had 58 on our list and we have now added 25 for a total of 83. That is a wonderful response, but unfortunately we still have a long way to go. With a current membership of 282 we need a total of 212 to be within the 75% range required by the IRS. That means we have a minimum of 129 to go. Again, your records at Post 209 are considered confidential. If you are a WWII veteran, your proof of service document will be called something other than a DD Form 214. Just remember what we need is the paper that lists your period of service. A fancy Certificate with your name and Serial Number is not usually adequate. If you need us to copy what you send and then send it back to you, please just give us a note to that effect when you send in your document. Thank you for your support of this very important project. 
