
# CENTENNIAL POST 209 THE AMERICAN LEGION

There was a break out session for adjutants which was both a review of past procedures and a briefing on new changes. One thing we were advised on was the amount processing time by Department and National. This is a six week process for the most part. you delay paying dues after renewal receiving your notice, there is a good chance you will get a second notice before your payment been recorded. National processes membership for close to 3 million members so this is not something done overnight. Check your card and your check register if you are in doubt.

This year all permanent member cards will be mailed directly to the member from department. program will be closed to new the National Paid Up members and For Life (PUFL) will start in July as the replacement. The bad news is PUFL costs a bit more than our The good news is that program. you may pay for this membership in one of three ways: 1) check for the whole amount; 10% down 2) continued payment and monthly payments until paid off; and 3) use your plastic money card.
