SBA SOURCE OF VALUABLE HELP FOR VETERAN OWNED BUSINESSES:

Washington (ALNS) -- The Small Business Administration (SBA) should be retained as a Federal agency with its loan authority and veterans affairs office left intact, the American Legion has told congress.

In testimony before the House Committe on Small Business, Emil Naschinski, the Legion assistant director of economics, attacked the Reagan administration's recent efforts to dismantle SBA and transfer many of its programs to the Department of Commerce. The Legion's opposition to such a move comes from the absence of any provision for the continuation of the veterans affairs office of SBA.

"Where are veterans to turn for technical assistance?" Naschinski asked.

The road to a veteran assistance program at the SBA has been a long and difficult one. The veterans small business loan program which was administered by the veteran's administration after World War II, was transferred to the SBA when the agency was created in 1953. Despite the passage of a 1974 law mandating the SBA to provide "special consideration to veterans," little was done until 1980 to promote the agency's veterans programs.

Naschinski reminded the committee that since 1981 the SBA has shown a continued commitment to veterans and its responsibilities under the law. In 1980 veterans received 12 percent of all SBA loan dollars. By 1985 the figure was up to 27 percent.

The administration plans to scrap the agency, the resignation of its chief, and the appointment of Charles Heatherly, who seems intent on dismantling SBA even without congressional authorization, have all worked to imperil the progress in small business technical assistance for veterans.

The Legion's testimony urged the committee's members to continue to look out for the special consideration veterans have received in the past, and to provide for continued assistance for veterans who seek to start a business.

ADMINISTRATION ABANDONS PLANS TO SCUTTLE SBA

Washington (ALNS) -- The Reagan administration has announced that it will no longer seek the dismantling of the Small Business Administration (SBA) as a separate federal agency. The American Legion along with other groups had opposed the effort to fold many SBA programs into the Department of Commerce.

As recent as the May meeting of the National Executive Committee, the Legion had called for continuation of SBA and its office of veterans affairs.

However, the administration is still seeking to sell the SBA's loan portfolio to the private sector, a move which meets with Legion opposition.

"Selling the loans is not a good idea," said Dennis K. Rhoades, the Legion's director of Economics. "We are skeptical about any effort to sell government loan portfolios after the chaos brought about by selling the VAs hom loans. The VA Home Loan program nearly collapsed after the government dumped its loan portfolio. We cannot_sit back and watch the same thing happen to the SBA program."

The SBA administers many loan program, including those which target veterans specifically as a special category for assistance.


