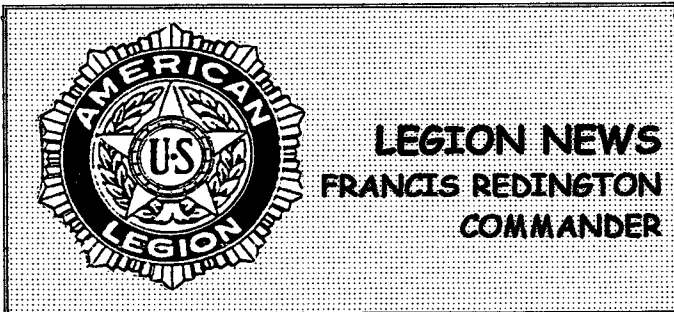

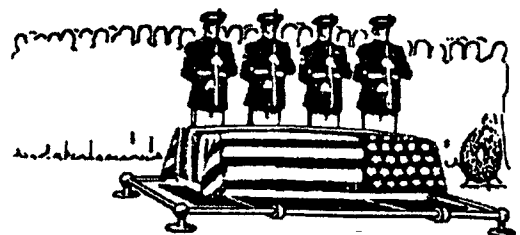

Smaller parts were built to be inserted into the network as soon as larger pieces were anchored into place. Many large poles had been placed into holes which measured from three feet to six feet deep. By Friday eight to ten poles had been set in concrete and many of the assembled smaller pieces were being anchored into place.

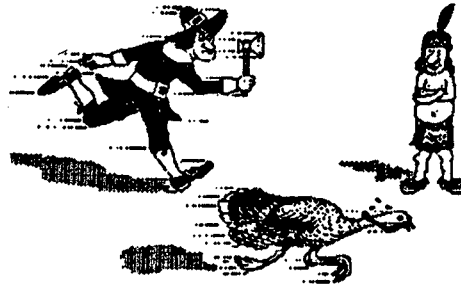
